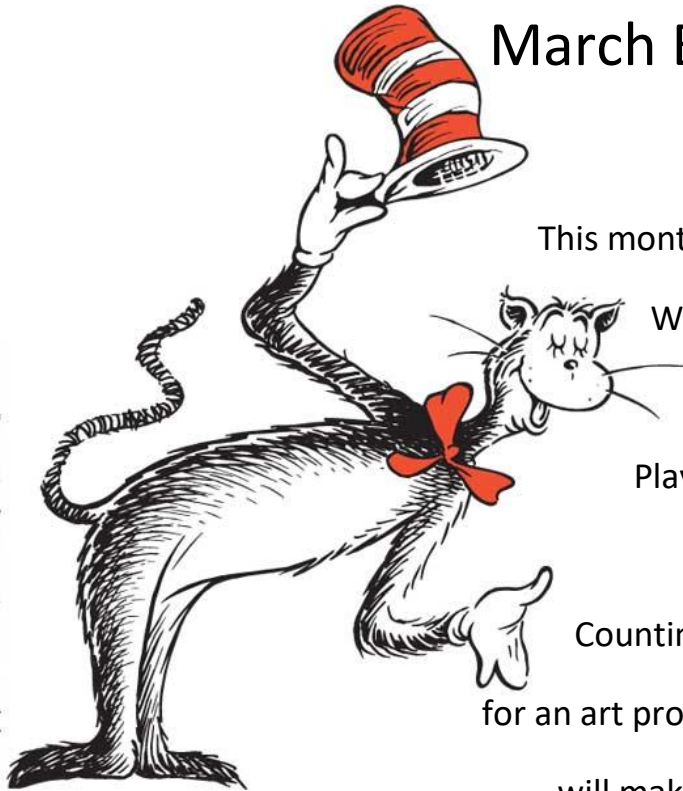


March Enrichment Class 2.5
