Monday, May 13 until Friday, May 17 is The Week of the Young Child. Please see schedule below according to your child's class.

M,W,F class

Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup>: Puzzle Pals with Mrs. Craft's class. You do not have to do anything for this day.

Wednesday, May 15<sup>th</sup>: Alphabet Day. Your child's letter will be posted in the hallway and on them (using a sticker) next week. Please dress your child in their assigned letter on that day. For example, if your child is "Y" dressing them in all yellow clothes would be sufficient.

Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>: Messy and Crazy Hair Day. Dress your child in clothes that can get completely messy and wow us with your crazy hair skills.

T,TH class

Tuesday, May 14<sup>th</sup>: Alphabet Day. Your child's letter will be posted in the hallway and on them (using a sticker) next week. Please dress your child in their assigned

letter on that day. For example, if your child is “B” dressing them like a baseball player or a bird or all in blue would be sufficient.

Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup>: Messy and Crazy Hair Day. Dress your child in clothes that can get completely messy and wow us with your crazy hair skills.

T,W,TH class

Tuesday, May 14<sup>th</sup>: Alphabet Day. Your child’s letter will be posted in the hallway and on them (using a sticker) next week. Please dress your child in their assigned letter on that day. For example, if your child is “M” dressing them in all white clothing for “milk” would be sufficient.

Wednesday, May 15<sup>th</sup>: Puzzle pals with another class. You do not have to do anything for this day.

Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup>: Messy and Crazy Hair Day. Dress your child in clothes that can get completely messy and wow us with your crazy hair skills.
