Denmark Tour July 28-August 7

This summer a group of 52 singers ranging in age from third grade to college, will travel overseas for a nine-concert performance tour. Thirty-five adults will oversee the group. The choir will perform 7 concerts in Denmark, one in Germany and one in Sweden in historic churches, some dating from 1100. Some songs will be in the native languages of Danish, German and Swedish; the repertoire includes classical masterpieces by Schubert and Allegri, folk songs and hymns and African-American spirituals.

This will be the fourth FPCM Denmark tour; the others were in 2006, 2009 and 2015. The tour participants will be commissioned during worship on Sunday, July 21 at the 9 a.m. traditional service.


New Devotional Guides Available for Ways 1-5
