- 5. How is Jesus calling us to join Him in a movement towards Freedom in our area?

**OUTRO**: You don't need to start a new movement to right every wrong. That movement has already started. On a cross 2000 years ago, Jesus began our movement towards freedom. You don't need to be Jesus, that job is already taken. Be John. Prepare the way for Jesus to save people, help people, embrace people, or free people. Be John and join Jesus in the work He is doing, but never forget your place. Jesus's job is too big for you. Don't be Jesus. Be John.
