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FPCM Way of the Week (Feb. 2-9)

6. FORGIVE....AGAIN. Just as God forgives us, heal relationships by extending forgiveness with grace and generosity. Forgive everyone everything. Start by praying for those you resent or hate. Ask for every blessing you would want for the <u>one</u> you're struggling to forgive.

- "If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will for give you if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins." (Matthew 6: 13, 14)
- Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. (Ephesians 4: 31)
- Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. (Colossians 3: 13)
