



OUTDOOR WORSHIP TO BEGIN SUNDAY, AUGUST 30

We've got some GOOD NEWS to share! Starting August 30th, we'll reunite for outdoor worship on Sundays at 8:30 a.m. (weather permitting). All are welcome! Worship will be held in the courtyard facing Bridgeboro Road, at the foot of the steps outside Miller Commons Lobby. Worship will last about 30-35 minutes and include live music, prayer and a sermon. Please wear a mask, bring your own chair, and practice physical distancing. Restrooms and the church building will remain CLOSED. Kindly arrive a few minutes early to allow for entry protocols. <u>ALL participants must register</u>. Please see the Events page on our website or the Church Center app to register.

Before arriving, all households must complete two forms. This can easily be done ONLINE as part of Registration:

- Health Screening Questionnaire
- Waiver (one per family)

If you prefer, you may PRINT the <u>Health Screening Questionnaire</u> and the <u>Waiver</u> and bring them with you. The 9:30 a.m. live stream will remain unchanged.
