



Way of the Week 13 (September 13-20)

- ◆ *Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." (Matthew 28: 19, 20)*
- ◆ *He said to his disciples, "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields." (Matthew 9: 37, 38)*
- ◆ *Don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity. (1 Timothy 4: 12)*

Ideas for Action: As you consider whatever it is that you do regularly here, keep a look out for a younger person or a new member to invite to join you in the task. If the job requires training or coaching, offer it. Look to let go and hand off.

In 1888, Eliza Clokey urged each woman to give one extra dollar to their contribution to the Women's General Missionary Society of the United Presbyterian Church of No. America as a "thank offering to her Lord." This special collection was credited with saving the worldwide missionary movement of the church. This year 15 projects were funded (13 in the US, 2 outside, in Ethiopia and the Dem. Rep. of the Congo. In accordance with the by-laws, 40% are related to health. In our PW Synod, the Family Promise program will receive monies to help renovate a building for use as a day resource center and emergency overnight facility.
