Welcome Dr. Thomas Kort

We warmly welcome The Rev. Dr. J. Thomas Kort to the pulpit on Sept. 6 to our 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. services. After 42 years in ministry as a senior pastor, Rev. Dr. Kort retired in 2015 - for two weeks before accepting the invitation of his alma mater Princeton Seminary to the position of Associate Vice President for Advancement, where he engages with alums and congregations.

He graduated from Slippery Rock State University in PA, and pursued graduate studies in Counseling at the University of Pittsburgh before being called to the seminary. A gifted minister, Dr. Kort served congregations in Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Ohio and North Carolina for 42 years as a senior pastor.
