### Download the "Church Center App" To Your Phone; Check-In for Worship



Beginning October 11, members will now be able to **check-in** quickly and easily from their smart phone. (1) Download the "Church Center App" to your phone from either the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android). (2) Follow prompts to enter the church's name or zip code (08057). (3) Select "**Check In**" when you arrive and look for the check-in icon (QR code). ### Consecration Sunday is October 18

Please make plans to virtually attend the 9:30 a.m. live stream worship on **Sunday, October 18** as *together*, as an act of worship, members will complete their 2021 Estimate of Giving cards. In early October, cards will be mailed to all members so that households may prayerfully (and safely) indicate their gifts. Dedicate your gifts in person with a contact-free Drive-Up Dedication Parade, where members of the Stewardship team will receive your sealed envelope through your car window as the pastors bless all in the vehicle and this gift to the church and the Lord's Work.
