Indoor Worship to Begin Sunday, November I

At a special meeting last week, Session approved protocols to move to indoor worship beginning Sunday, Nov. 1. Steps have been taken to ensure a safe and meaningful experience. This 9:30 a.m. blended worship will be in the Sanctuary, and limited to 75 attendees and 60 minutes. Worship will continue to be live streamed. The single point of entry will be the portico doors. Everyone must enter through the glass Commons doors to check in then walk across the parking lot. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival, and all individuals must complete the Health Questionnaire and COVID-19 Waiver. Please wear a mask, and stay home if you are experiencing COVID symptoms or do not feel well. There will be NO reservations for indoor worship. Seating is on a first come, first served basis only and overflow will be seated in Miller Commons to view on screen.

Those who live together may be seated together. In all other cases, physical distancing will be marked. Attendees are asked to download the Church Center App to their smart phone to facilitate a contact -less check-in upon arrival.

Download the Church Center App to Check-In

Members are now able to check in quickly and easily from their smart phone. Here's how:

- Download the "Church Center App" to your phone from either the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android).
- (2) Follow prompts to enter the church's name or zip code (08057).
- (3) Select "Check In" when you arrive and look for the checkin icon (QR code). Tap the icon when attending an on-campus service or gathering to scan your phone and record your attendance.
