Holy Week Schedule (See our events page and website)

- Good Friday Tenebrae Worship, April 2: 7:00 p.m. Tenebrae Worship; Frantz Constant preaching. Tenebrae features a gradual extinguishing of candles and "strepitus" or loud noise taking place in the darkness - Sanctuary, in-person worship.
- Easter, April 4: He is Risen! 6:30 a.m. Sunrise Worship at the Cemetery Cross, Lord's Supper (in-person outside); 8:30 a.m. Contemporary Worship *Miller Commons, live stream only*; 11:00 a.m. Traditional Worship *Sanctuary, live stream only*.
