



THE GREAT COMMISSION: MISSIONOPOLY

HOW TO PLAY

Bag contents: Game board, small bag with dice, movers (prayer dolls), and houses, Mission cards (property cards if you were playing Monopoly), “?” and Mission Possible cards. Also included in the bag is our devotional and information about upcoming events at FPCM.

Object of the game: To have the most mission cards when all of the cards are taken.

Begin your journey by watching the videos for each of the missions. They can be found at <https://www.fpcmoores town.org/missionopoly>. After watching the video, attached a house to the game board so you will know which ones you have finished. The videos are all short (around five minutes at the most). We encourage you to watch as many videos as possible to get to know these wonderful organizations and to ace our trivia night.

Pick a time to play the board game. The oldest player goes first and then it goes by descending age. Roll the dice and move your mover around the board. When you land on a mission, find the corresponding mission card and read it aloud for your fellow players. Everyone should listen carefully to this as you will have an opportunity to take the missions away from the other players just by remembering something about the mission.

Take turns rolling the dice and moving your movers. If you land on a mission that is already taken, you may take it away (steal) it from its owner by simply stating a fact on the card. Continue playing until all of the mission cards are gone. The winner is the person who has the most missions at the end of the game.

If you land on “?” or Mission Possible, take a card from the stack and follow the instructions.
