

#### Seven Essential Elements of the Gospel:

- 1. God's Kingdom is here.
- 2. Jesus is the Christ.
- 3. Jesus died for our sins.
- 4. Jesus was resurrected.
- 5. We repent of sin.
- 6. We believe the Gospel.
- 7. We follow Jesus.
