

<u>New protocols ---</u> Session has revised COVID-19 safety protocols through October. Masks are mandatory when gathering indoors (both those vaccinated and unvaccinated) when <u>Burlington County</u> is deemed to have high or substantial community spread. <u>At this time we are requiring masks</u>. This applies to worship and all indoor meetings. Congregational singing is discontinued, singers are masked, and seating is distanced. We'll continue to serve communion in pre-packaged units, and will not serve or eat food indoors. Food may be eaten outside.
