Why September 12th?

In 1886, a small group of Moorestown residents began gathering for regular prayer and worship in each other's homes. On September 12th, 1888, twenty-nine of those faithful individuals committed to becoming the first members of the First Presbyterian Church of Moorestown, New Jersey. We celebrate September 12th as the birthday of our church. This year, we will be turning 133!!

What is the September 12th Fund?

This fund began in 1993, when our Interim Pastor, Dr. Bryant Kirkland, and church treasurer Dr. James Honan, conceived of creating this special fund as a way to celebrate our past and invest in our future. The September 12th Fund serves as a type of long-term endowment for our church. Your gifts to the fund are held and invested for the care and protection of our church over time. Each year, a designated portion of the earnings are used for current church needs. It is the gifts of those who came before us that are helping us do the work of our church today.
