Officer Ordination and Installation

In Baptism, each Christian is called to ministry in Christ's name. God calls some persons from the midst of congregations to fulfill particular functions, so that the ministry of the whole people of God may flourish. In ordination, the Church sets apart, with prayer and the laying on of hands, those who have been called by God through the voice of the church to serve as officers of Christ's Church. In installation, the Church sets in place, with prayer, those who have been previously ordained as Deacons, ruling Elders, and other areas of ministry in Christ's Cchurch (adapted from the Book of Order; W-4.0401).


