IT IS OFFICIAL...the 2022 Strawberry Festival was a HUGE success!



We were fortunate that the Lord blessed us with beautiful weather to ensure that our first post-pandemic Strawberry Festival was the best one yet! The glorious return of this event brought thousands of people from our congregation, Moorestown, and nearby communities. While it's difficult to tell for sure, we believe we had over 4,000 people attend! If you weren't there, we missed you, and hope you can come next year. Some highlights of the night were long lines of kids ready to bounce on an inflatable or get their face painted, the Missions food tent working so hard to feed the crowd and raising \$1,664 to donate to Haiti Outreach Ministries, the Community Band on the main lawn, and Jonathan Miller's rocking debut with the Trophy Husbands band!

We are SO grateful for those members of our congregation who volunteered. It's because of YOU this event went so smoothly and many people felt welcomed to our church. From donating cakes to washing and hulling strawberries to working on the night of the event to staying way past a shift time to wash a sink full of dishes (Vicky Terry!!) we thank you from the bottom of our hearts. You made our jobs easier and you are ALL appreciated.

So many of our Ways come to mind when planning an event of this magnitude: *Speak the Truth With Love ... Jump In ... Join Hands ... Own Our Church ... Welcome Change Show Who You Really Are.*

Truthfully, it was a struggle to get volunteers to staff all the stations needed as well as to account for the required number of cakes. We lost many volunteers who were normally present, due to COVID caution, moves, family trips, or no longer being able to serve. We were only halfway to our goal of 300 cakes up until 3 days before the event, so we bombarded you with emails through one committee or another to donate cakes. (Which then looked ridiculous because our congregation went above and beyond, so that we had an over abundance of cakes!) Unfortunately, because it was late in the week, we had no idea that people would bring MORE than they had signed up for or brought cakes they had not signed up for at all because of our panicked begging! We appreciate all that was donated and luckily, were able to give the leftover cakes to Feeding 5000, Moorestown Police Department, the local Buy Nothing group and our own coffee hour table, which was a blessing for each recipient. While that was a lovely gesture, the time, money and resources expended to ensure there were sufficient cakes could have gone elsewhere in the critical days leading up to the event.

We ask you to consider the Ways listed above and this verse when it comes to hosting this event again next year, and in the years to come: "Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the Lord your God that he has given you." (Deuteronomy 16:17 ESV)

Please consider how you can be of service next year. If you are able to physically volunteer the night of the event, please do so. If you are unable to serve on that night, please consider coming to hull strawberries the day before, help set up the day of or by donating cakes-homemade, store bought, or money towards the purchase of what's needed. We'll be planning early this year, so the earlier you can make a commitment, the better! We are excited to have each of you involved in helping us make the 2023 Strawberry Festival THE BEST EVER. 
