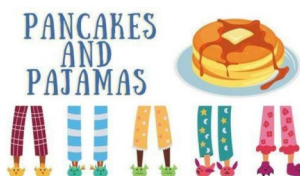
Missions Dine and Donate

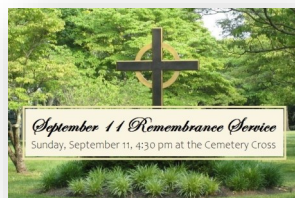
