Leon graduated from Cincinnati Christian Seminary in 1987 and started his ministry in Cite Soleil in 1988. Haiti Outreach Ministries began in 1990 in Port-au-Prince, Haiti with

Pastor Leon as the founding director. Through HOM, he and his wife Jacky and daughter Nadege have built three churches, four schools and two clinics as well as developed the leaders in Haiti needed to sustain the ministry. They have recently broken ground for a Bible College. Many of our members have been on mission trips to Haiti. FPCM has sent mission teams to this ministry 11 times with the first after the 2010 earthquakes.
