Stephen Ministries

Way 18 reminds us to Ask For Help. Sometimes this is very hard. Often, though, we need help. Sometimes the only way to receive this is to ask for it. Part of being a Christian means relying on God for help. We can pray directly to God, we can ask the church to pray for us, we can talk to the minister. God's answers come in many ways. One way God can answer your prayer is by putting a Stephen Minister in your life. In our church, many lay people have answered the call to become a Stephen Minister, completing a 50-hour training program. We currently have 14 active Stephen Ministers including five active Stephen Leaders who have received extra training to help administer the program. A Stephen Minister will meet with you for about one hour each week, listen to your problems and help you get through the tough times with God's guidance.

Stephen Ministry provides a safe place to ask for help. This confidential program only works when caregivers are paired with care receivers. The difficult part of this ministry is getting those who need help to ask for it. Sometimes a friend or family member will suggest you ask for a Stephen Minister. *Remember none of us can go it alone. Ask for help.*

And if you find that you believe you are able to help others, our next Stephen Ministry class begins in October. Call <u>Doris Kahley</u> at (609) 261-8474 or <u>Wes Allen</u> at the church office (856) 235-1688 to ask for a Stephen Minister or to ask about our new class.
