

Grow the Kingdom I Will Pray – Daily Prayer Guide

I will pray regularly for the ministry and mission of FPC Moorestown.

¹¹ So we keep on praying for you, asking our God to enable you to live a life worthy of his call. May he give you the power to accomplish all the good things your faith prompts you to do. ¹² Then the name of our Lord Jesus will be honored because of the way you live, and you will be honored along with him. This is all made possible because of the grace of our God and Lord, Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians 2: 11 - 12

⁹ So we have not stopped praying for you since we first heard about you. We ask God to give you complete knowledge of his will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding. ¹⁰ Then the way you live will always honor and please the Lord, and your lives will produce every kind of good fruit. All the while, you will grow as you learn to know God better and better. ¹¹ We also pray that you will be strengthened with all his glorious power so you will have all the endurance and patience you need. May you be filled with joy, ^[c] ¹² always thanking the Father. He has enabled you to share in the inheritance that belongs to his people, who live in the light.

Colossians 1: 9 – 12

Thank you for praying for First Presbyterian Church of Moorestown! Your prayers are a gift; and God is pleased when we pray. You can pray through this list, though don't feel you have to. We cover many items on this list. We've included two examples (above) of prayers that the Apostle Paul prayed for churches. You can borrow his language as you pray for our congregation.

What to Pray For

- **1.** That we would have unity amid diversity—loving those with whom we have nothing in common but the gospel. That the Holy Spirit will keep us united in the bonds of love.
- 2. That a culture of discipling would form in which making disciples—of children, youth, young adults and adults of every age—will be viewed as an ordinary part of the Christian life here at FPC Moorestown.
- 3. That the Holy Spirit would guide us as we seek to better love and care for the children, youth and young adults of our congregation and community. Pray for our Staff members and church members who lead our various youth ministries: Sunday school, fellowship programs, youth groups, choirs, and Discovery Bible Studies.
- **4.** That our faithful teachers, youth leaders and pastors would use Scripture to train, equip, correct and encourage our members to do the work of ministry.

- **5.** That a hunger for studying the gospel will form among our members so that we may become more Christ-like in our lives.
- **6.** That transparent, meaningful and accountable relationships would become normal and remaining isolated and alone strange.
- 7. The preaching of God's Word by our pastors—that it would be biblically carefully and Holy Spirit filled. That the Holy Spirit would, every Sunday, open the hearts, minds and wills of our people as we hear God's Word preached.
- 8. That the members of our Session, Deacons, Trustees and Staff would remain above reproach, kept from temptation, complacency, idols, and worldliness.
- **9.** That the church's songs would teach members to biblically confess, lament, and praise. That God will continue to bless and use our music and choral ministry.
- **10. That the church's prayers** would be infused with biblical ambitions, honesty, and humility. That those who are want to pray will learn how to pray.
- **11.** That FPC Moorestown would grow in being distinct from the world in love and holiness, even as it engages outsiders.
- **12.** That members would share the gospel this week—and see more disciples made!
- **13.** That the Lord will bless other churches and other ministries in Moorestown. Pray for other congregations in town will flourish and grow. Pray for other pastors and Christian leaders.
- **14.** That members would be prepared for persecution, remembering to love, not curse, their persecutors.
- **15. That giving would be faithful**, as well as joyful, consistent, and sacrificial. Ask that the Lord will provide everything we need to do His work.
- **16.** That more members would use their education and careers to take the gospel to places it's never been.
- **17. That members would be good and do good** in their homes, schools, clubs and work places this week.
- **18. That the Holy Spirit can use our 25 Ways** to shape the culture of our congregation into an atmosphere thick with love.
- 19. That God will bless, protect, guide and provide for our local and international mission partners.
