<u>Capital Sunday</u> is February 25: Capital projects are essential for continued maintenance, safety, and preservation of our church. The Annual Report included a list of capital improvements prioritized by the Trustees. The anticipated cost for these projects is \$170,000. Because of budgetary restraints, no capital funds were budgeted for 2024. Leadership is offering the congregation the chance to give specifically to these projects during a Capital Campaign. The purpose of this Campaign is to raise the necessary funds for both current and future capital improvement projects. Contributions to the Capital Fund can be made through the online giving portal or by utilizing Capital Fund envelopes.
