
Way of the Week 17: Show Who You Really Are

As Presbyterians, we are a *connectional church*. This "per member" contribution of \$38.75 above one's pledge supports the General Assembly, Synod and Presbytery and our church is required to pay this.

If you do NOT wish the church to pay your Per Capita, you must <u>submit an opt-out form</u> online. Last year, our church paid \$20,973 from its operating funds for non-responding members. Please note not responding is NOT the same as opting out. Due February 29th.
