The church must pay



this assessment for all non-responding members (we paid \$20,973 last year). See your mail for more information.

THANK YOU for your generous kickoff to our Capital Fund with Capital Sunday – we've received nearly \$45,000 for capital projects. We're well on our way. The Trustees have developed a list of projects that require attention in the upcoming years for \$170,000, of which \$82,000 are High Priority. Because of budgetary restraints no capital funds were budgeted for 2024. Instead, leadership offers the congregation the chance to give to specific projects during a Capital Campaign.
