
Way of the Week 5: Assume Positive Intent



5. ASSUME POSITIVE INTENT. Decide to trust that other members are being fair, honest, and concerned for the wellbeing of our church. Set aside your own judgments and preconceived notions. Surrender the urge to criticize and judge – it doesn't help. Graciously give people the benefit of the doubt.

As a community of believers we are linked with others through these faith statements. They include the Nicene Creed (AD 325), Apostle's Creed (AD 340), Scots Confession (1560), Heidelberg Catechism (1563), Westminster Confession of Faith (1647), Second Helvetic Confession (1562), Shorter Catechism (1647), Larger Catechism (1647), Theological Declaration of Barmen (1934), and the Confession of Belhar (1982). All represent the understanding of Scripture in the Reformed tradition. The Book of Confessions can be accessed on our PCUSA website.


