5. ASSUME POSITIVE INTENT. Decide to trust that other members are being fair, honest, and concerned for the well-being of our church. Set aside your own judgments and preconceived notions. Surrender the urge to criticize and judge — it doesn't help. Graciously give people the benefit of the doubt.

One phrase has remained with me from having memorized Luther's *Small Catechism*: 'Put the best construction on everything.' **Choose** to evaluate everyone's words and deeds in as positive a light as possible. After all, how often could our <u>own</u> words or actions be misinterpreted? Thomas a Kempis wrote, 'In judging others...we are often mistaken and easily sin.' This needs to be a conscious choice, as is any act of love. In a world in which angry accusations are the norm, be the light of Christ, and treat other people exactly as you would like to be treated by them. (Matt. 7:12)
