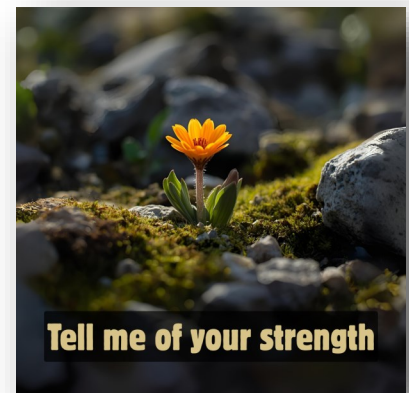
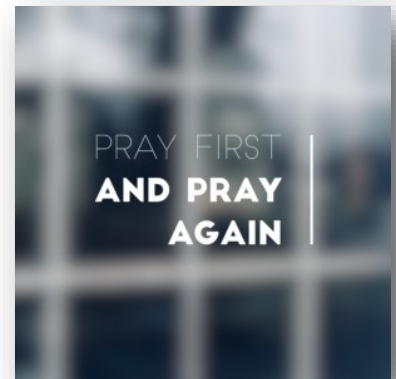

friends! Please let Stuart know if you can help with set up or clean up.

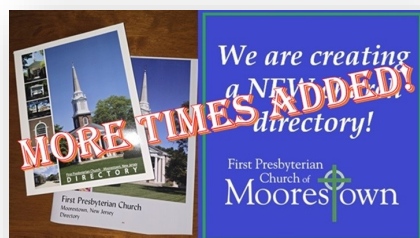


Thanksgiving Postcards

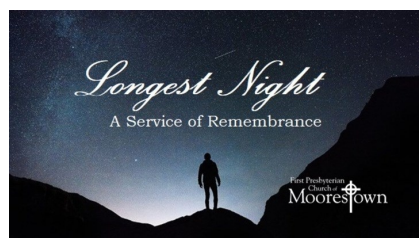

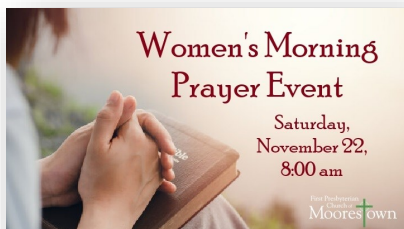


NEW: "Hot Topics"
