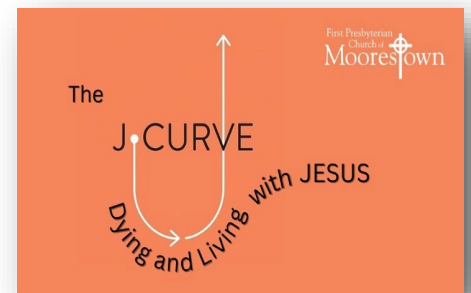
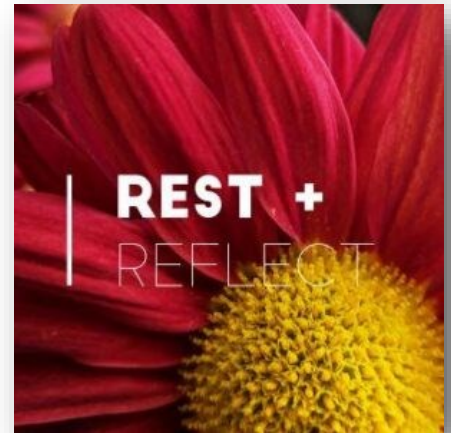
Rest and Reflect

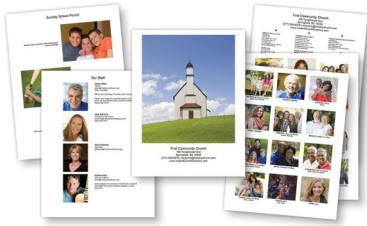
Lenten Study

Celebrate Black History Month Through Music

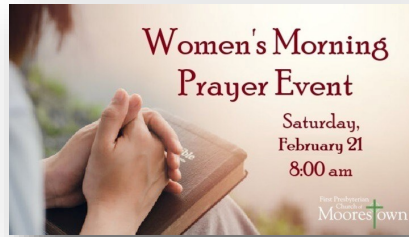
*"African-American Spirituals:

Grace Boutique

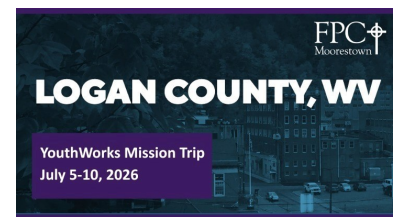

NEW: Adult Spiritual Formation Series

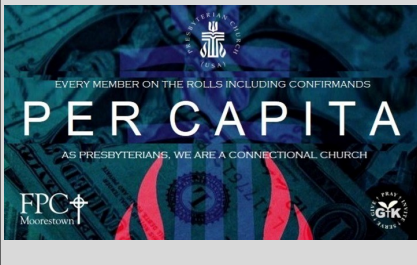
